WHO CAN APPLY

Herren Project's mission is to support, inspire, and empower those affected by substance use disorder. We are committed to preventing the misuse of substances, encouraging wellness, and celebrating the power of being YOU.

All applicants must demonstrate a leadership role in the prevention and awareness of substance use disorder within their school and/or local community.

Herren Project's Scholarship Program is open to all high school seniors who plan to further their education at a trade school, community college, or four-year university.

HOW TO APPLY

Submit an essay showing how you have embodied one or more parts of Herren Project's mission. Essays should not exceed 550 words. All applications must include a recommendation from a teacher, advisor, or adult mentor.

Applications must be submitted by 5pm ET on April 25, 2025. They will be reviewed by our scholarship committee and recipients will be notified by May 5, 2025. Scholarship recipients will be featured on the Herren Project website, social media, and newsletters.
